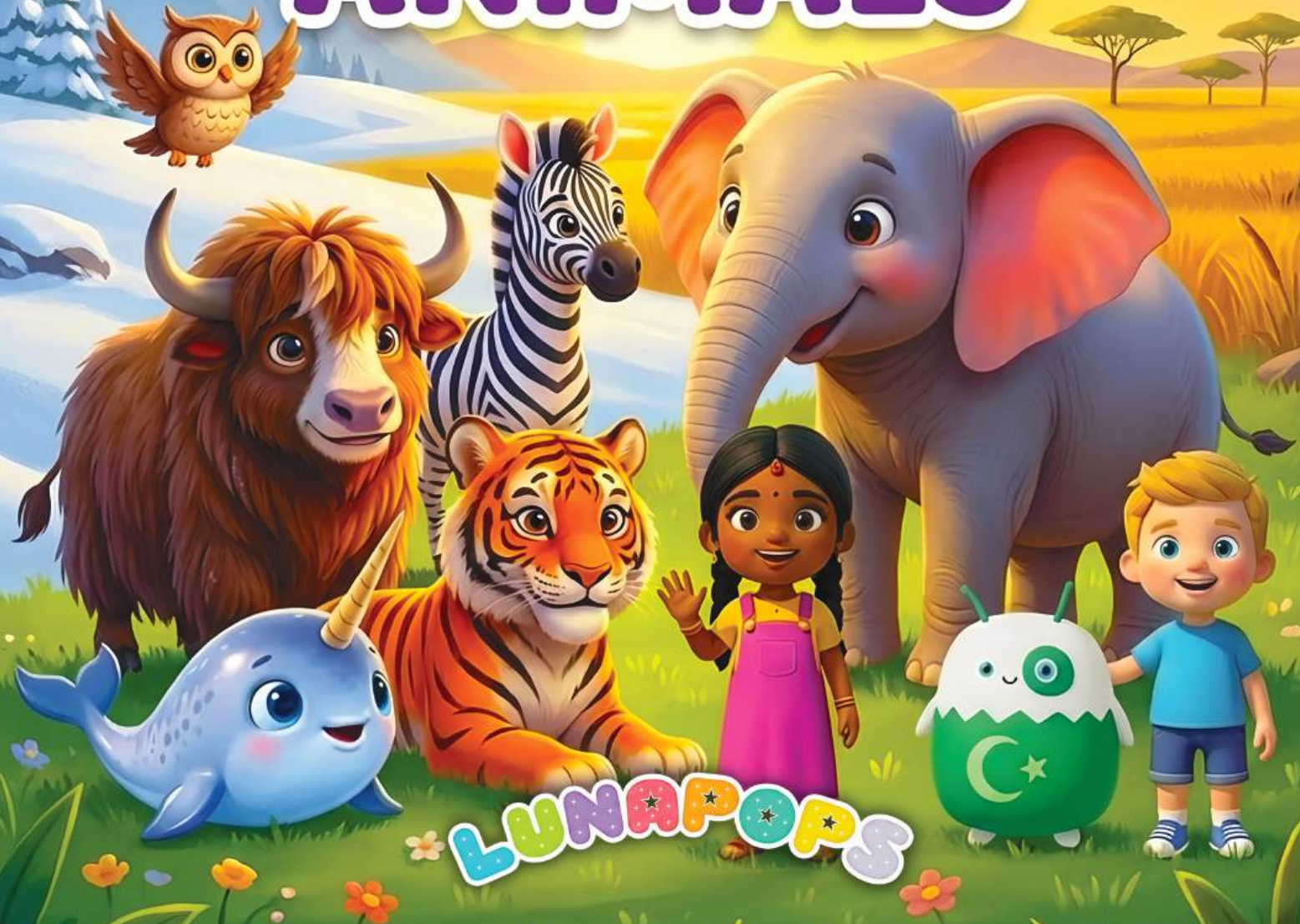

beautiful spots.



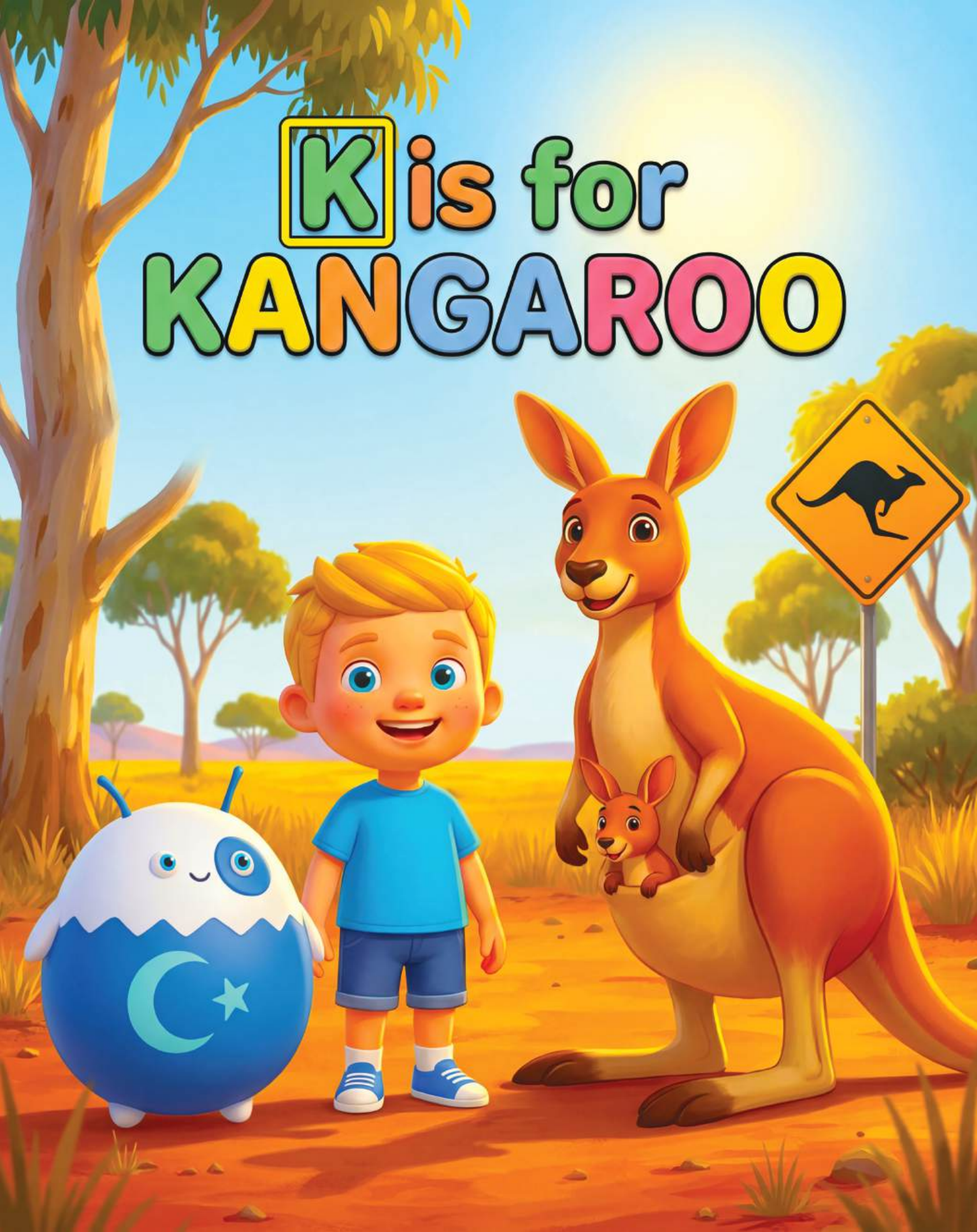
Jaguars love

Monkeys love to swing from tree to tree.

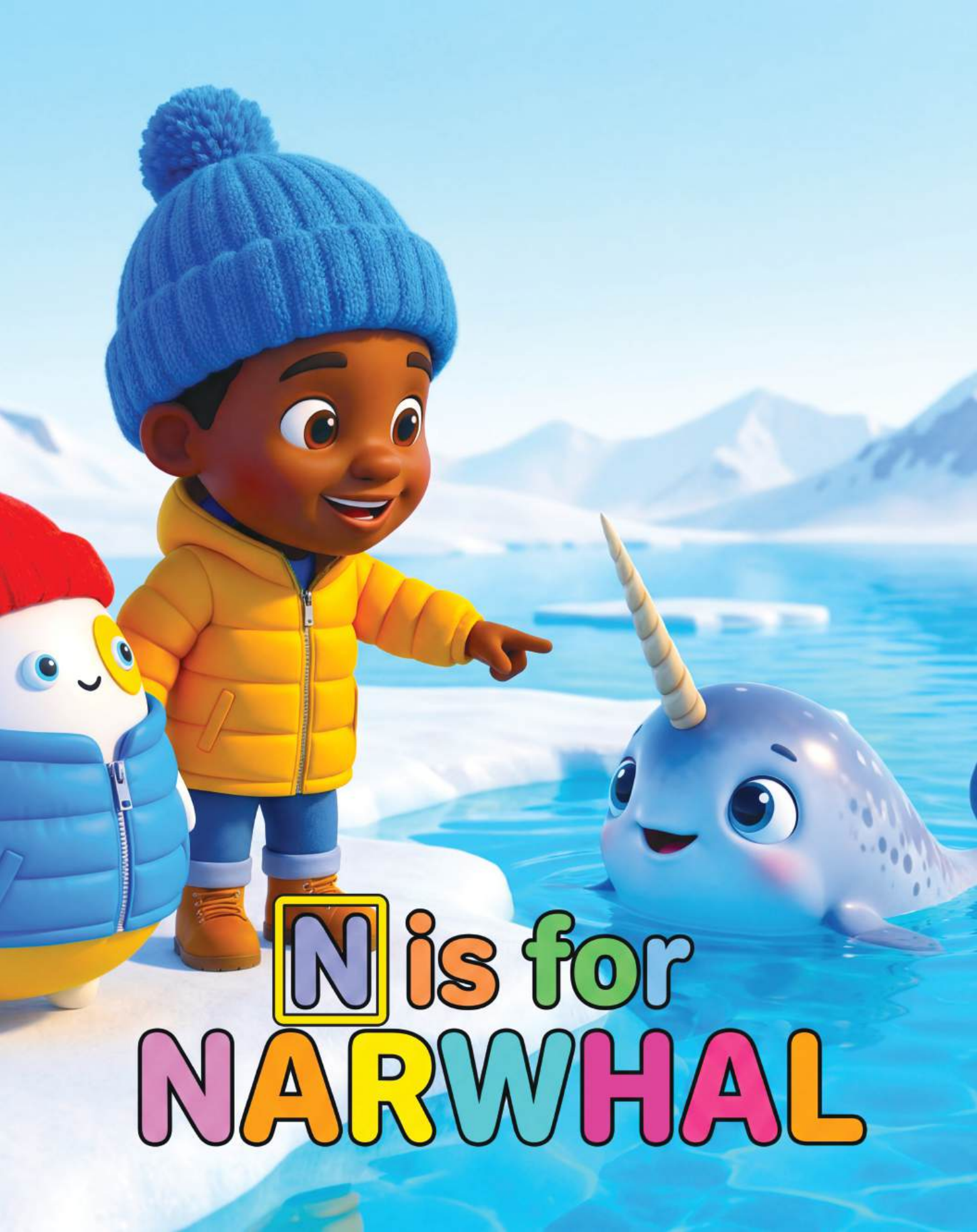


Monkeys use their tails like an extra hand.

Vultures help keep the earth clean and tidy.



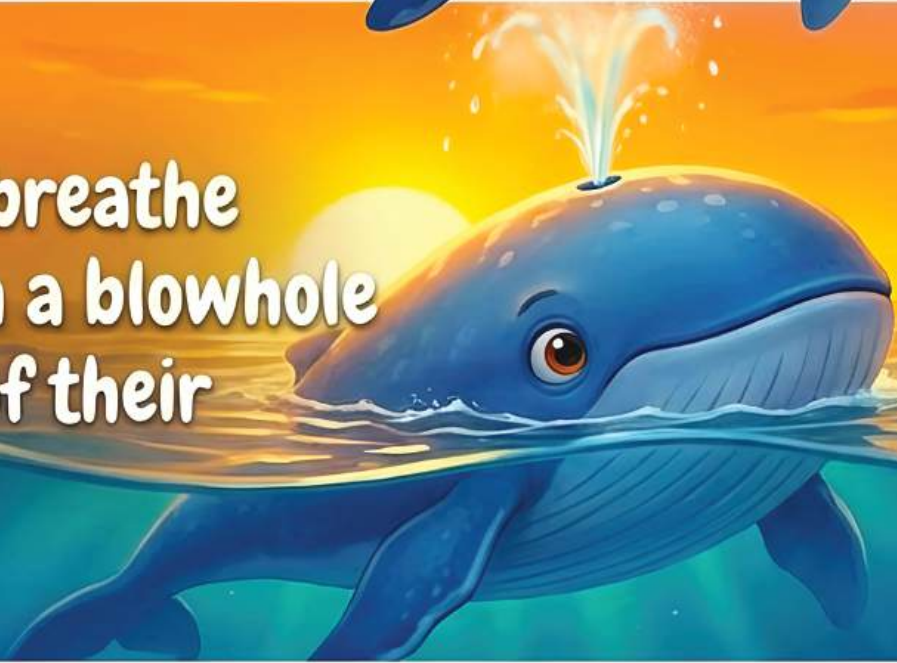
W is for

X-RAY FISH

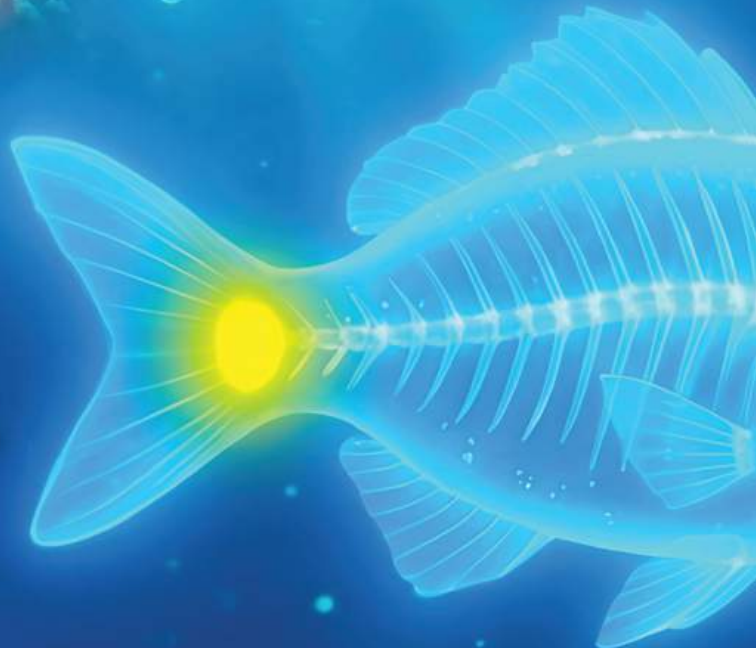


**X-Ray Fish are
